Read small passages slowly

Ask questions

What does this passage help me **know about** God?

How does this passage help me **connect with** God?

What does this passage invite me to **do**?



Wholistic Scripture Reading

Head

Over-emphasis on **knowing about** God can lead to harshness without a changed heart and life.

Heart

Over-emphasis on **connecting with** God without a foundation of truth can lead to delusion.

Hand

Over-emphasis on **doing** can lead to legalism and an exhausting need to please God.



Isaiah 43:16-19

This is what the Lord says – He who made a way through the sea, a path through the mighty waters,

Who drew out the chariots and horses, the army and reinforcements together, and they lay there, never to rise again, extinguished, snuffed out like a wick:
